

RESOLUTION NO. R-21-G

A RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF NEOSHO COUNTY UNDER COUNTY CONTROL, ALL IN NEOSHO COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Neosho County Commissioners that, in the interest of public safety, during construction on Kansas Highway 169, it is prudent to temporarily modify the speed limit of certain portions of Neosho County Kansas, which are under County control and located in Neosho County, Kansas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NEOSHO COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The speed limit of the following portions of the following county roads, shall be temporarily modified to thirty (30) miles per hour: 190th Road (35th Street) west from 169 Highway to Chase Road, Neosho County, Kansas.


SECTION 2. The modification set forth in Section 1, above, shall apply to traffic traveling in both directions on each applicable road set forth above.

SECTION 3. The Neosho County Road and Bridge Department, or its designee, as determined by the Neosho County Road and Bridge Director, shall erect appropriate signage to indicate the speed limits enacted hereby at appropriate locations.


SECTION 4. The aforementioned signage shall be erected and placed in accordance with Kansas law.

SECTION 5. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in at least one of the official county newspapers.
