

COVID 19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. R-22-C

WHEREAS, on the 7th of January, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners of Neosho County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Neosho County, Kansas resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in Neosho County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Neosho County, Kansas.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Neosho County, Kansas;


That the state of local public health emergency in Neosho County, Kansas declared on the 7th day of January, 2022, shall continue and remain in effect until 45 days unless terminated earlier.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Neosho County, Kansas and shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law for 45 days unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.
