

RESOLUTION NO. R-23-C

A RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A SPEED LIMIT
MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF NEOSHO COUNTY UNDER
COUNTY CONTROL, ALL IN NEOSHO COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of Neosho County, Kansas that, in the interest of public safety it is prudent to temporarily modify the speed limit of certain portions of Neosho County, Kansas, which are under County control and located in Neosho County, Kansas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF NEOSHO COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The speed limit on Chase Road between 190th and 200th Road and on 190th Road from US Highway 169 west to Chase Road shall be modified to thirty (30) miles per hour.

SECTION 2. The modification set forth in Section 1, above, shall apply to traffic traveling in both directions and on each applicable road set above.

SECTION 3. The Neosho County Road and Bridge Department, or its designee as determined by the Neosho County Road and Bridge Director, shall erect appropriate signage to indicate the speed limits enacted hereby at appropriate locations.

SECTION 4. The aforementioned signage shall be erected and placed in accordance with Kansas law.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect upon publication in the official county newspapers.
