PERSONAL PROPERTY FORMS THAT WERE MAILED BY APPRAISER

Personal Property Rendition forms will be mailed by the Neosho County appraiser's office at the end of December they are due back in the appraiser's office by March 15th.

These forms include a computer printout listing the items reported in 2019, according to Robert McElroy county appraiser. Residents need to make corrections, deleting items disposed of and adding new items. If you have received a form but no longer have personal property you still must return the rendition, marking the box that you no longer own or control any personal property. If there are no changes sign the form and return to the county office by March 15.

McElroy emphasizes that you return your rendition before the filing deadline. All Personal Property Rendition Forms must be returned by March 15 and must be signed and dated. According to state law, the penalties for late filing are: Within 15 days, 5%; within 16-30 days, 10%; 31-45 days, 15%; 46-60 days, 20%; over 60 days, 25%; and failure to file is 50%.
